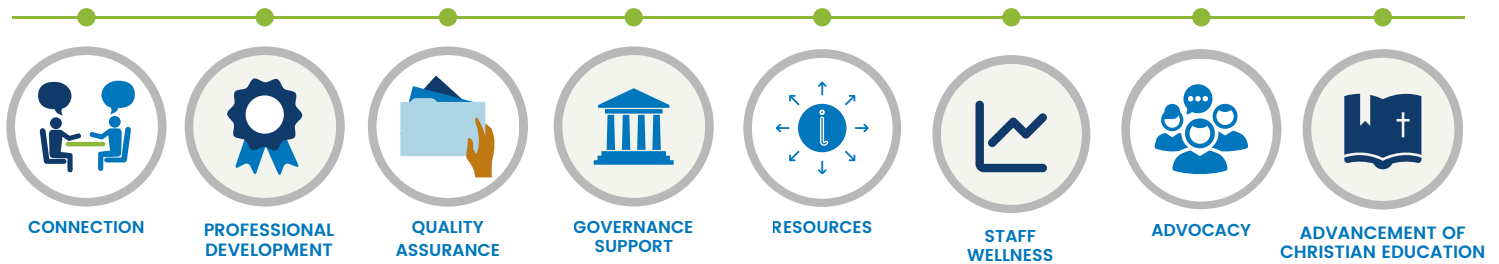

The ACSI Christian School Improvement Platform (CSIP) was developed by the ACSI Europe office and has been introduced across Europe and in South America. The total is an aspirational, meaningful way to reflect on and maintain excellence in ACSI schools. For an in-depth summary of exactly what the CSIP entails, visit acsi.co.za

Currently, the cost of using the Christian School Improvement Platform is included as part of your ACSI partnership fee. This arrangement will be reviewed on an annual basis.



WHERE TO START

It is recommended that you discuss the implementation of the CSIP with your management, staff and possibly also with your board. It will require input from all stakeholders in the school to be really meaningful and shouldn't be rushed. Then, if your school is interested and is an ACSI school, log in with your school editor details, and head to the CSIP page where you will be able to register on the South African CSIP site.

STANDARDS

Standards were developed from the ACSI REACH, INSPIRE and PSI accreditation and school improvement programmes.



ACCESSIBLE

The platform is online, which means that costs can be kept low.



ASPIRATIONAL

The first phase of the process is a self-assessment in which a small, representative team from your school goes through the various standards and indicators to assess where areas of strength and weakness exist. Thus the whole process is aspirational rather than something imposed from outside.



STRATEGIC

After the self-assessment, a report will be generated with recommendations. From this report, strategic goals are developed by your school, which lead to a strategic school improvement plan.



PEER-REVIEW

The final stage of the process is a peer-review process, in which ACSI directors, as well as experienced principal colleagues, are invited to the school to develop an even deeper accountability. This phase may or may not be requested by a school. It will not be imposed on a school.



LEGAL SUPPORT

ACSI has a number of legal service providers who are available to provide quick advice and assistance through the ACSI office. While we may not be able to take on cases on behalf of our schools, we provide legal feedback and advice through the counsel received from our service providers.

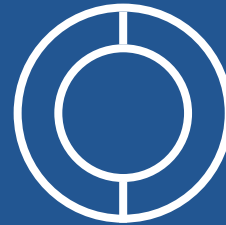
PAYMENT PLANS

THE DEADLINE FOR ALL PARTNERSHIP FEES IS THE 31ST OF OCTOBER



FULL PAYMENT

Due Date: 31 March. By making a full payment by the due date, your uncapped school can qualify for a 10% discount on the annual ACSI partner contribution fee. Please note that this discount only applies to uncapped schools, as capped schools have a separate fee structure.



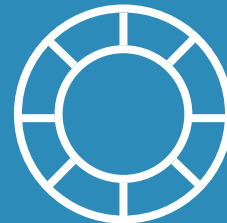
BI-ANNUAL

Due Dates: 31 March and 31 July. This payment option allows you to split your annual ACSI partner contribution fee into two equal payments, due at the end of March and end of July respectively.



6 EQUAL PAYMENTS

Due Dates: 31 March, 30 April, 30 June, 31 August, 30 September, and 31 October. This payment option allows you to divide your annual ACSI partner contribution fee into six equal payments, spread out over the year.



8 EQUAL PAYMENTS

Due Dates: 31 March, 30 April, 31 May, 30 June, 31 July, 31 August, 30 September, and 31 October. This payment option allows you to make smaller monthly payments toward your annual ACSI partner contribution fee.

Please note that if the calculated fee is greater than the capped amount per annum, ACSI will cap the partner contribution fees. Also, if a capped partner school pays before the 31st of March, the school will pay a further reduced capped fee.

CODE OF ETHICS

Spiritually

- Live according to the Word of God.
- Accept the Statement of Faith of ACSI.
- Accept the Vision and Mission Statement of ACSI.
- Accept the Core Beliefs of ACSI.
- Acknowledge the noble calling of our profession to educate and train the learners in our schools in Spirit and in Truth, according to God's Word.

Administratively

- Adhere to relevant legislation for existing as an independent school.
- Observe good practice.
- Meet local health, safety and sanitation standards.
- Operate within the parameters of the constitution of our country.
- Do not discriminate on any basis.
- Register with the State/Provincial Education Department.
- Maintain standards that are not inferior to standards at comparable public educational institutions.

Principals and Boards

- Ensure sound and effective management and control.
- Offer adequate programmes to meet the needs of all admitted learners.
- Hire educators who are qualified.
- Maintain the freedom to provide an educational programme which satisfies academic standards.
- Provide facilities that are appropriate for any educational programmes that ACSI may offer.
- Engage in ongoing school improvement and in the core components as outlined below:
 - Truth
 - Intellectual Development
 - Christian Educators
 - Potential in Christ
 - Operational Integrity

As Educators

- Act in a proper and becoming way such that their behaviour does not bring Christ or the teaching profession into disrepute.
- Acknowledge the uniqueness, individuality, and specific needs of each learner, guiding and encouraging each to realise his or her potential as stated in Psalm 139:14: "You are fearfully and wonderfully made."
- Endeavour to enable learners to develop a set of values consistent with the Word of God.
- Pursue excellence in every area of education.
- Provide for the spiritual, intellectual, emotional and physical needs of learners.
- Teach from a Biblical Worldview perspective, focusing on Spiritual Formation.
- Offer adequate programmes to meet the needs of all admitted learners.
- Teach, learn and assess knowledge, skills, values and attitudes.
- Acknowledge that the attitude, dedication, self-discipline, ideals, training and conduct of the teaching profession determine the quality of education in our schools.
- Exercise authority with compassion.
- Avoid any form of humiliation, and refrain from any form of abuse, physical or psychological.
- Use appropriate language and behaviour in any interaction with learners, and act in such a way as to elicit respect from the learners.
- Take reasonable steps to ensure the safety of learners.
- Not show negligence or indolence in the performance of their professional duties.
- Recognise parents as partners in education, and promote a harmonious relationship with them.
- Do what is practically possible to keep parents adequately and timeously informed about the well-being and progress of each learner.

PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT

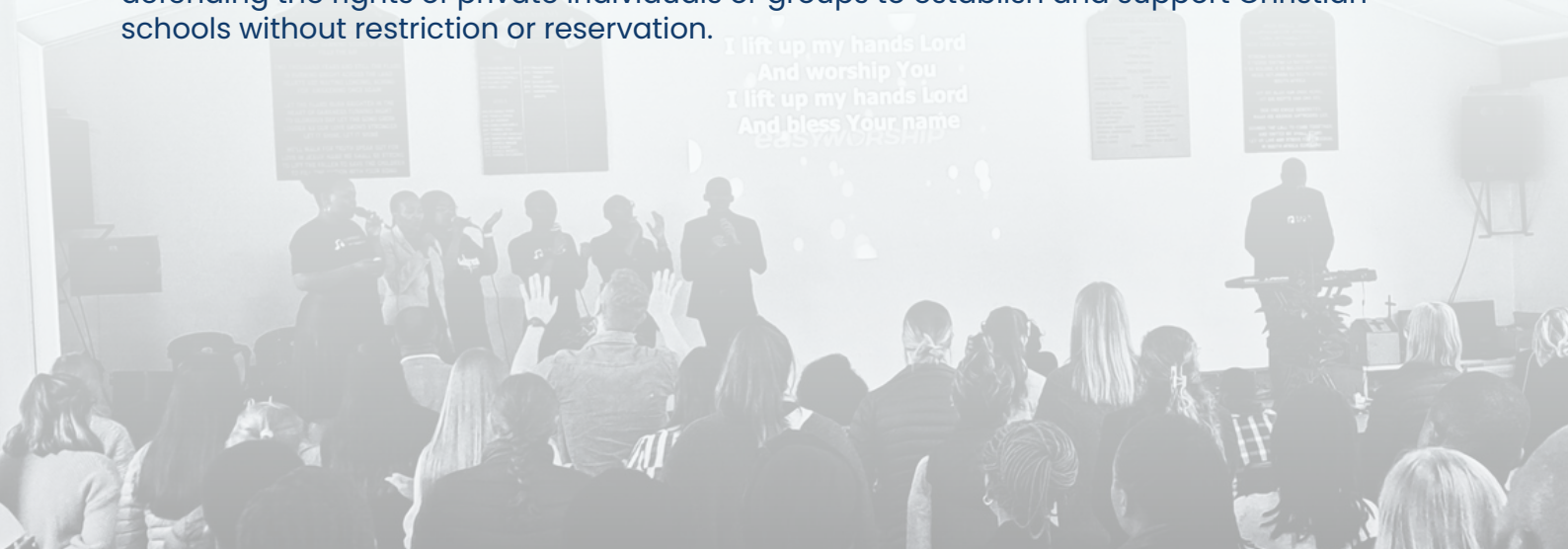

We believe:

In the absolute necessity of regeneration by the Holy Spirit for salvation because of the exceeding sinfulness of human nature; and that men are justified on the single ground of faith in the shed blood of Christ and that only by God's grace and through faith alone are we saved (John 3:16-19; John 5:24; Romans 3:23; Romans 5:8-9; Ephesians 2:8-10; Titus 3:5).

In the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; they that are saved unto the resurrection of life, and they that are lost unto the resurrection of damnation (John 5: 28-29).

In the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ (Romans 5: 8-9; 1 Corinthians 12:12-13; Galatians 3:26-28).

In the present ministry of the Holy Spirit, by whose indwelling in the Christian, we are enabled to live godly lives (Romans 8:13-14; Corinthians 3:16; 1 Corinthians 6:9-16; Ephesians 4:30; Ephesians 5:18).
